Students are also required to take a laboratory course, which is typically 1 credit hour. The remaining six (6) required credit hours are psychology electives, and students may fulfill these hours in a variety of ways. Majors must take at least six credit hours from 400-level psychology courses, with at least three hours from courses numbered between 400 and 489. BIOSC 470 may be taken in lieu of one 300- or 400- level elective psychology course. Students should consult their departmental advisor for other degree requirements and course recommendations.
