



Internship...

Work or project related to a student's major or field for a substantial period of time to make the experience meaningful for both the company/organization and the student.

Keys To A Successful Internship

- Internships should be *meaningful* and *productive* both for the employer/organization and for the student.
- Projects that give student some degree of independence will allow student's use of initiative.
- The immediate supervisor of the intern will have a significant impact on the success of internship.
- Developing a short job description will enhance the success of the internship.
- Internships may be paid or unpaid.
- Paid Internships are typically paid at a commensurate that a full-time employee of similar skills and responsibilities are paid. (Typical national average for these majors \$10.00 - \$25.00/hr.)
- Internships may be full or part time.
- Internships may be in spring, summer, and fall or just one of these time-frames.
